**PROGRAM ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- ◇ Must be a high school graduate and have a diploma or an official transcript from an accredited school, or have a GED (General Education Development) Diploma
- ◇ Acceptable scores on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) - 11.0 grade Reading, 11.0 grade Math, 11.0 grade Language
- ◇ Acceptable scores on the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) - 40% Reading, 40% Math, 40% Language, and 40% Science. \$30 registration fee. [www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com)
- ◇ Interview with the program counselor
- ◇ Completion of Health Careers CORE or equivalent with necessary updates
- ◇ Completion of physical/immunization forms by a physician.
- ◇ Successful completion of a Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) Level II Background Check - \$47
- ◇ Pass a drug screening test - \$27

*ALL students entering the Practical Nursing Program (Term 1 or above) must complete ALL of the above entrance requirements whether a first time student or an advanced student.*

Regular class hours for Terms 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 4A, 4B and 5 will be Monday, Wednesday and Thursday 5:00 pm – 10:00 pm. Full time clinical experience is required, therefore, it is mandatory for part time evening students to attend class Monday – Friday, 2:00 pm – 10:00 pm or 8:00 am – 2:30 pm the last nine weeks (Term 5) of the Practical Nursing Program.*
