



Drug Screening

1. Pay **\$27.00 by cash or credit card** (no personal checks accepted) to the registration office which is located in the Student Services Building at McFatter Technical Center.
2. You will be given a receipt by the registrar.
3. Bring this receipt to the Medical Building and give it to the secretary in the Medical Office.
4. The secretary will then give you a **Lab requisition sheet**.
5. Take this requisition sheet to any of four testing sites listed below on this page.
6. The **Labcorp Medical Review Officer** will contact you with positive or questionable results. These results will first be sent to designated school personnel.
7. Students who fail one or both tests will be referred to Guidance and School Administration for Career Education and/or Drug Counseling in accordance with the **Broward County School Board Code of Student Conduct**.

Turn right on N.W. 178 th Avenue and then an immediate left into the Pines Profession Campus. When you reach the first stop sign, stop and turn left. Look to the right and you will see building L. The suite is located on the first floor #103, directly across from the Allstate Insurance Office.

Information for students:

- Bring a valid driver's license or official picture identification
- Bring the LABCORP lab requisition with you that was approved by the school
- Bring a copy of your permission slip (notarized if you are a minor)

Students not "cleared" as a result of background tests should understand that the final decision related to program entrance or retention will be rendered by the school board or Broward County's Special Investigative Unit. (Drug screening results indicating a possible misuse of drugs is used to deny program entrance or retention. Such results will be discussed with the student and parent, or guardian, if required and appropriate action will be initiated.) Anyone not cleared in both background check and drug screening will not be allowed at the clinical facility; therefore, will not be allowed to enroll in any Health Science Education Program.
